Subject : Verizon Partner Solutions Industry Letter: Oakland 1 PA DMS100 Switch Retirement

PLEASE NOTE:

- All references to the Oakland 1 PA DMS100 switch are associated with CLLI code PITBPAOKDS0 and will not be repeated throughout this letter.
- All references to the Oakland PA CS2K switch are associated with CLLI code PITBPAOKPS0 and will not be repeated throughout this letter.

As set out in the Verizon Pennsylvania LLC Short Term Public Notice Under Rule 51.333(a), dated May 4, 2026, on or after June 29, 2026, the Oakland 1 PA DMS100 switch will be retired and removed from the Verizon network as part of ongoing efforts to modernize the network.

General Information: The Exchange Codes (NXXs) in Numbering Plan Area (NPA) 412 currently residing in the Oakland 1 PA DMS100 switch (see list in Table B below) will be moved to the Oakland PA CS2K switch (see details in Table A below).

The two (2) native NPA NXXs belonging to the Oakland 1 PA DMS100 switch will be rehomed upon decommissioning of the switch and reflected in the Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG) for the Oakland PA CS2K switch. This will occur on or after June 29, 2026.

Network Changes and Trunk Rearrangements:

The Oakland PA CS2K switch will be the recipient office of traffic migrated from the Oakland 1 PA DMS100 switch. Traffic bound for the codes listed in Table B will be delivered via the Oakland GT0 Tandem (PITBPAOKGT0).

After all traffic is migrated off of the Oakland 1 PA DMS100 switch, this switch will be retired and removed from the network.

All ASRs for the Oakland PA CS2K switch must be received no later than May 25, 2026, to provide sufficient time to migrate the traffic described above. All traffic must be moved by June 29, 2026.

Please adhere to industry standards using normal procedures that pertain to updates and changes to the LERG for all NXXs subject to the retirement of the Oakland 1 PA DMS100 switch.
